




- Board Instructions


Board Identified Region -Kirschenmann / Hudson Park



Board Identified Region -Richland / Rodriguez Park




Board Identified Region - Mannel Park

Notes: East Shafter Too Large for Single District




East Shafter is too Populous for 1 single district.

Decision must be made on where to cut region


Mannel Park Region within East Shafter

Board Identified Regions are not large enough for single districts; they will need additional areas to reach ideal population.


Board Identified Regions do not overlap with COIs.












